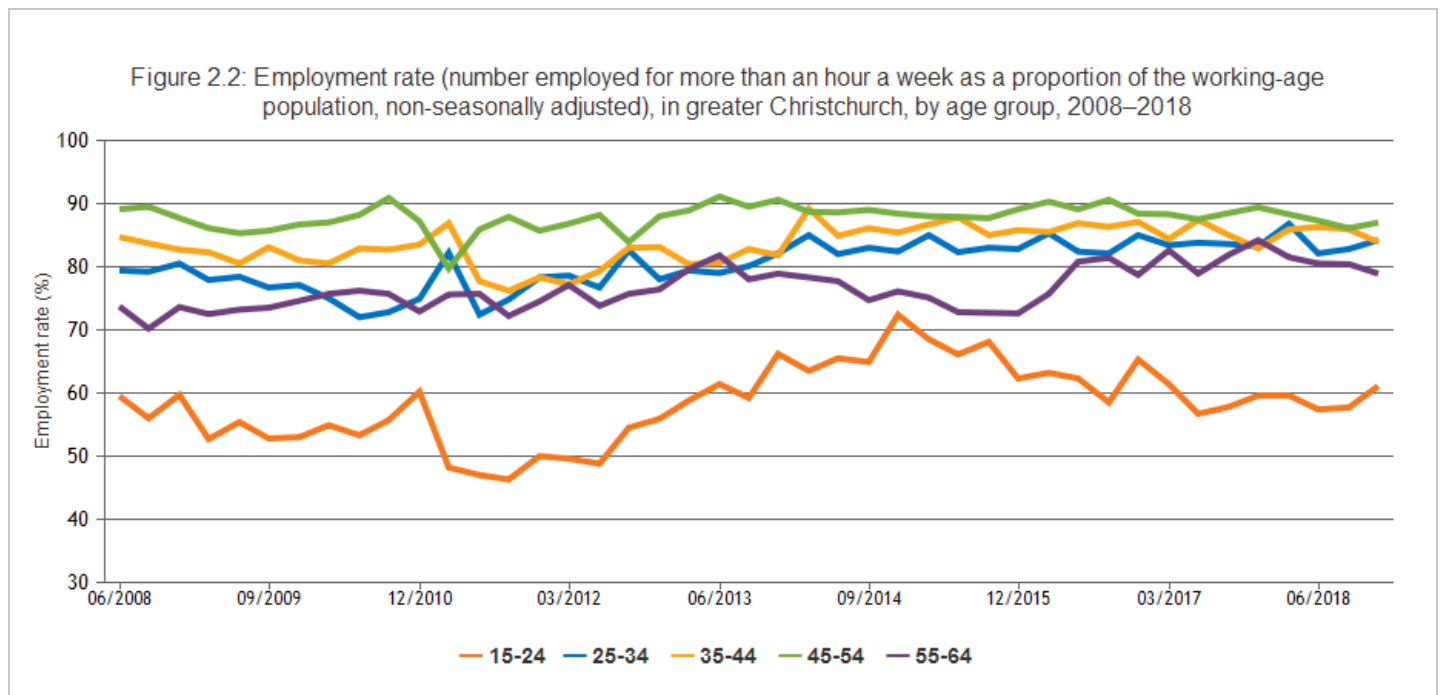


Employment rate: Breakdown by age

The figure shows a pattern of generally increasing employment (non-seasonally adjusted) for greater Christchurch over the last ten years, and a pattern of convergence between the age groups. The employment rate for younger people (15–24 years) appears to have been influenced by earthquake and rebuild-related activities; declining substantially following the start of the Canterbury earthquake sequence, before rebounding during the years 2012 to 2015, then flattening from 2016 to the most recent result of 61.1 percent.
