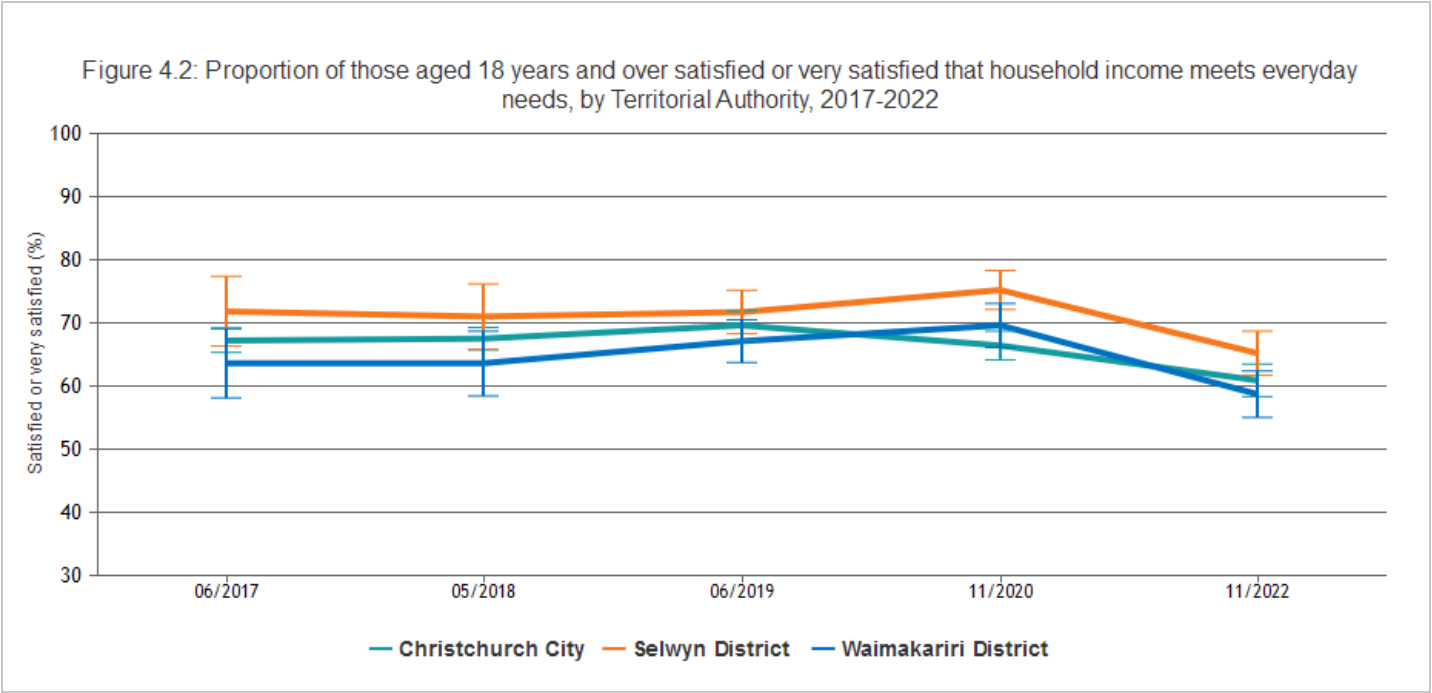


Satisfaction with income: Breakdown by Territorial Authority
